- PINOT GRIGIO VENEZIE 2005. (CIELO) 14.00

N.E. Italy. Super-smooth with a spicy edge.

Burgundy. Zingy clean, classic French wine-making.

South Africa. Real complexity from a top player.

Burgundy. Premier crû. Steely clean chardonnay.

N. Spain. Smooth, dry, hint of oak. Nice Spanish character.
- TIERRA ANTICA  
CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2005. 14.00  
175ml. glass: 3.50 250ml. glass: 5.00  
Chile. Ripe dry flavours and fine bouquet too.
- ECHEVERRIA CABERNET SAUVIGNON  
RESERVA 2004. 16.00  
Chile. Top-notch alternative to claret. Savoury and dry.
- DOGAJOLO 2004. 16.00  
Double magnum (4 bots.) 58.00  
Italy, Tuscany. Innovative mix of local saingiovese and cabernet (chianti claret?). Smooth and packed with fruit.
- CHIANTI CLASSICO 'SAN JACOPO' 2004.  
(CASTELLO VICCHIOMAGGIO) 18.00  
Italy, Tuscany. Smooth, ripe, modern chianti unusually made by Englishman, John Matta.

## FRUITY RED

- COLECCION MERLOT 2005. (TORINO) 14.00  
175ml. glass: 3.50 250ml. glass: 5.00  
Argentina. A favourite grape; soft, very fruity character.
- SAINT CLAIR PINOT NOIR 2005. 18.00  
175ml. glass: 4.50 250ml. glass: 6.50  
New Zealand, Marlborough. Three St. Clair's on the list? Yes, our favourites. Classy alternative to good burgundy.
- HAMILTON RUSSELL PINOT NOIR 2005. 29.00  
South Africa. Fine cool-climate pinot. South Africa's finest, and world class. The bright fruit shines through.

## FULL RED

- ADEGA DE PEGOES 2005. 12.00

Portugal. Solid dry red from near Lisbon. Great value.
- FOUNDSTONE SHIRAZ 2004. 14.00

S. Australia. Big but fruity too. Shiraz is this country's top red grape, and here's a typically good example.
- BERTON RESERVE SHIRAZ 2004. 18.00  
S. Australia. Bold, brambly Barossa style. A1 quality.
- DON DAVID RESERVE MALBEC 2004. 16.00  
Argentina. Malbec is **the** Argentine grape; they have made their own. Dark, deceptively strong.
- PENNY'S HILL  
GRENACHE 'CADENZIA' 2004. 21.00  
S. Australia. Treated properly as here, the grenache makes strong, beefy reds. Hits you between the tonsils!
- CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE CAILLOUX 2003. 29.00  
S. Rhône. Superb estate, with a dark, brooding style.
- BEAUNE LES BRESSANDES 2002. (MOROT) 34.00  
Burgundy. Classic Côtes d'Or pinot noir. A good grower and premier crû vineyard. Opulent and smooth.
