1	<b>Tuatara Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2005, New Zealand</b> A light bodied, dry, crisp wine with typical Marlborough flavours of gooseberry, guava, nettles and just a hint of honeysuckle and lime.	12.5%	£3.50	£4.50	£12.95
2	<b>Foundstone Unoaked Chardonnay 2005/06, Australia</b> This unoaked Chardonnay offers a rich and creamy mouth feel that leads to lovely soft tropical fruits and orange zest on the palate. Zingy acidity underpins the flavours and keeps them lingering on the palate.	12.5%	£3.25	£4.25	£12.50
3	<b>Berton Reserve Cowra Chardonnay 2005, Australia</b> This Chardonnay displays generous aromas of passion fruit and mango, beautifully balanced with the toasty honeycomb oak. 4	<b>Pinot Grigio Venezia IGT 2005, Italy</b> A dry white wine with a mineral character and a round and spicy flavour.	12%	£3.50	£4.50	£12.95

6	<b>Saint Clair Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2005/06, New Zealand</b> A full and crisp, powerful wine with intense aromas and flavours of passion fruit, blackcurrant, underlying gooseberry and herbal tones. 7	<b>Petit Chablis 'Special Cuvée' Domaine Jean Goulley 2004/05, France</b> Refreshingly clean with a crisp, mineral and dry finish. The Special Cuvée is made in a fuller style with longer ageing on the lees to give weight.	12%	£3.90	£5.50	£15.95
8	<b>Hazy View Chenin Blanc 2006, South Africa</b> Fresh and aromatic aromas with crisp acidity, finishing on a long, fruity note.	12.5%	£3.25	£4.25	£12.50
9	<b>Head Over Heels Forgotten Riesling 2005, Australia</b> 100% Riesling late picked grapes that were 'forgotten' on the vine, allowing them to develop a perfect balance between fruit, sugar and acidity. 10	<b>Coleccion Torrontes de Cafayate 2005, Argentina (Organic)</b> Spicy, fresh tropical fruit character with hints of lychees and a crisp finish. Less intense than Gewürztraminer and an ideal partner to Asian cuisine				£15.50
11	<b>Hamilton Russell Chardonnay 2005, South Africa</b> A tight, mineral style of Chardonnay with classic Hamilton Russell vineyards length and complexity. The wine has bright, natural acidity and depth indicative of the extremely low yields used to produce this elegant wine.				£24.50
12	<b>Saint Clair Riesling 2005, New Zealand</b> This light-bodied, easy drinking wine shows distinct Riesling characters of ripe limes and grapefruit on the palate. The wine has a distinct mineral note and good fruit weight which follows through with well balanced acidity and a round smooth pleasing finish.				£15.90
13	<b>Pouilly Fumé 'le Champ des Vignes', Domaine Tabordet 2004, France</b> Characteristic flinty nose and palate opening out to show floral and dried fruit scents. Good weight, full bodied with balanced acidity through to a dry and citrus zesty finish.				£18.95
14	<b>Pinot Grigio "Andrea di Pec" IGT della Venezia Giulia, 2005, Italy</b> A top quality dry, fruity and crisp white wine from the Pinot Grigio grape grown on the gravelly plains of the Friuli. Mineral with a hint of nuttiness and spice on the finish.				£15.95

|    | A lovely aroma of buttered toast combined with yellow fruits such as peach and apricot lead to a generous and well-balanced palate. A wine which will be best drunk within 3 - 4 years but can age up to 10 years when cinnamon and roasted flavours will develop, adding mature complexity. |               |

 Delicate salmon pink colour from short maceration on the skins and a well sustained, elegant and fresh, fruity flavour.
